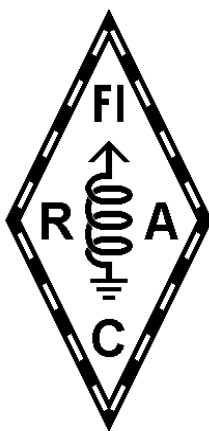


# **FIRAC – VHF - Contest Rules and Regulations**

**Date:**                      June Saturday 3rd, 12.00 - 17.00 UTC  
**Band:**                      2 m (144,150 ... 144,400 MHz)  
**Stations to be worked:**      all  
**Mode:**                      SSB  
**Call:**                      CQ FIRAC Contest  
**Digit replacement:**        RS and current number from 001 and locator  
                                    FIRAC stations: + "FIRAC"  
**QSO points:**                Each bee-line kilometre covered counts a point. The locator system is the basis for the distance calculation. Contacts by packet radio, satellites or other active repeaters are not evaluated.  
**Multiplier points:**        per worked FIRAC station a point  
**Rating:**                      OSOs are scored only if the station is displayed in at least two logs  
**Total points:**              Sum of the QSO points multiplied by the sum of the multiplier points  
**Log:**                      Please send your log in the "EDI" format to the FIRAC Contest Manager, within 14 days.

**Distinctions:**              Medal for the 3 first stations, documents for the five best stations

**Closing date:**              14 days after the contest (postmark)
